The key teachers in the Lower Nursery are Mrs Natalia, Mrs Erika and Mrs Justyna. The Upper Nursery teachers are Miss Kerry, Miss Jacquie and Mrs Andrea. Miss Lindsey is our classroom assistant. Mrs Lea is our dance teacher who teaches on Tuesdays. We offer the children free-flow play (choice of garden and classroom play based learning) and a balance of child-initiated and adult-directed activities. Most mornings, the children have access to two focused activities. One activity is within a group and the other activity is part of the free-flow play system, available to all the children. Teachers also continue to work individually with each child. Our free-flow plan is also posted up so that you can see how we have prepared the environment according to the children's interests.

This term's project is "Traditional Nursery Rhymes and Poems". The notice board outside describes our weekly project activities that provide suggestions for follow up ideas at home. This information is also on our website. Feel free to bring in any resources related to our project that you might have at home and we will take good care of them.

On Monday the Upper Nursery children will take it in turns to share their adventures with our class bears. Each week on Friday, 'Goggy', 'Fuzzy Wuzzy' and 'Shylo' will go home with a member of the class and we ask the children to record their adventures in the book. The books and bears are to be returned on Monday morning and your child will have the opportunity to share their experience with the rest of the class. The Upper Nursery has a literacy focus activity on Monday and an additional phonics session on Thursday.

We also invite parents to prepare and supervise an art activity every Wednesday morning for the Lower Nursery and every Tuesday morning for the Upper Nursery. A list has been posted on the notice board for parents to sign up. If you need help with resources, we are very happy to provide you with any materials you require. Please ask the teachers for any help with ideas.
