**Dear Parents,**

**The activity for week 2 beginning 22<sup>nd</sup> January is: The London Eye**

**The activity we will be covering involves:**

Learning about the iconic London Eye

Developing awareness of the city where we live

Encouraging an interest in the world around them

Working with different sizes of circles and different shapes to create the London Eye

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**Our activity includes:**

Children will be invited to look at a video clip about London; they will be asked if they have visited the different land marks shown in the video.

Children will be shown different images of the London Eye and we will have a discussion on how they think the big wheel turns around.

We will also look at London transport such as the underground, black taxis and red buses.

Children will participate in an art activity which involves working with different sizes of circles and different shapes to create the London Eye.

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**You might wish to help your child to explore this topic at home or when you are out and about. Please feel free to approach the teachers for further explanations.**

**Our suggested activities are:**

Take a bus trip around London; visit the London Eye, Big Ben and Houses of Parliament.

Look for shapes in the environment especially wheels and circles.

Encourage your child to play with Lego, stickle bricks or wooden blocks to create different structures which recreate different London land marks.
