Dear Parents,

The activity for week 2 beginning 14th January is: The Gingerbread Man

Learning objectives:

1. Learning about sequencing, knowing what happens first, second, third.
2. Developing new vocabulary, communicating thoughts and ideas independently.
3. Encourage children to use creativity and imagination.
4. Develop problem solving
5. Build on fine motor skills.
6. Promoting a sensory experience by using different materials and scents to enhance the experience.
7. Understanding the world, encouraging critical thinking.

Our activity including:

Using visual aids sequencing the story of "The Gingerbread Man"

Moving onto more problem solving skills arranging pre-cut images of the story together like a puzzle and sticking it on a big sheet of paper.

Painting a gingerbread man using paint with different smells such as chocolate, vanilla, cinnamon, lemon.

Decorating gingerbread man shapes with different sized beads and using tweezers or tongs.

Our suggested activities are:

- Read traditional tales stories from around the world to your child.
- Bake gingerbread men with your child.
- Make some 'ginger scented' playdough
