The activity for week: 2 beginning: 20.09.21

Is: Unique me

The activity we will be covering involves:

- Reading a story called “what if we are all the same-

- We discuss parts of the story as we read along. We talk about how we are all different from one another and yet so unique. We talk about how we are all good at something, our strengths and celebrate that. We might go around and discuss our physical characteristics and how we are different from one another and what makes us unique.
- Each child will be presented a certificate for being proud of who they are to celebrate his or her strengths.

Our activity includes:

Each child will be given a template of a figure and I will invite the children to use the template and decorate it to represent themselves. From painting it in their skin tone to adding hair, eyes and even clothes. The grown-ups will then ascribe on it what makes each child unique as expressed by them.

You might wish to help your child to explore this topic at home or when you are out and about. Please feel free to approach the teachers for further explanations.

Our suggested activities are:

- Organise a portrait day at home. Each member of the family will have to draw a picture of another member of the family for example daddy can draw a picture of you and you can draw a picture of mummy. After you finish you can all tell each other what you think makes each other unique and special. You can cut out all the pictures and stick them together to create a lovely family picture.



- Make a happy jar filled with things you like and once a week you pull out a card and treat yourself to one of your favourite things. It could be reading your favourite story, having an ice cream, jumping in muddy puddles. You can do this as a family.
