Dear Parents,

The activity for week: 6 beginning: 18th October

Is: ‘Celebrate our beautiful planet... The Earth’

The activity we will be covering involves:

- Learning and discussing some facts about our planet.
- Talking about the earth and the ocean’s pollution.
- Learning new vocabulary such as: environment, preservation, pollution, recycling, nature...
- Developing sensorial skills by manipulating different materials.

Our activity includes:

- Look at images of the Earth and the ocean on the interactive white board, look at some books related to the subject.
- Show the children a globe pointing out ‘where on earth we live’.
- Talk about some actions we can take to avoid the pollution of our planet and to promote Nature preservation.
- Invite the children to join in various exciting activities related to our earth and oceans such as: ocean art, rescue sea creatures, ocean sort and clean, earth sun catchers, earth balloon stamping and mess free earth painting.

You might wish to help your child to explore this topic at home or when you are out and about. Please feel free to approach the teachers for further explanations.

Our suggested activities are:

- Visit the Wetlands Centre to learn more about Nature and preservation.
- Talk to your child about what you and your family do and could do to help our planet (recycling, walking, cycling or scooting to places and to school)
