The activity for week: 10 beginning: 30.6.22

Is: My Journey to reception / Look how you have grown!

The activity we will be covering involves:

This week we will be focusing on the transition to Reception for the Upper Nursery Children and celebrating how much the Lower Nursery have grown and changed.

The Upper Nursery Children will go on a special tour of the top two floors of the school and spend a bit of time in the Reception classrooms. The Reception teachers will read them a story.

The Lower Nursery Children will listen to the story 'Oh the Places You'll Go' by Doctor Suess and we will look through some pictures together of the past year in Nursery. Each child can talk about their successes and favourite thing about Nursery.

Our activity includes:

- Reading the story Alfie and the Big Boys by Shirley Hughes
- Going on a 'tour' of the main school- going into our new classrooms
- Sharing and talking about photographs of our year at Nursery
- Discussing and exploring what the children have learnt/improved
- Looking at comparative pictures such as the prpgression of their self portraits
- Drawing a final self-portrait to place on our display
