Is: 'Journey around London'

The activity we will be covering involves:

- To locate London on the world map/globe.
- Learn about London and some of its famous landmarks.
- To locate some of the landmarks on a London map.
- To sustain attentive listening, responding to what they have heard with relevant comments, questions and actions.

Our activity includes:

Introduce the activity by talking about London and its landmarks, showing images in the IWB, books and objects related to the subject.

Encourage the children to talk about their own experiences.

Read the book "Paddington's Guide to London".

Explain the activity and work in teams to make a large scale London map using different media and working together; cutting, sticking, drawing, painting.

We will extend our activity celebrating the Queen's Jubilee with our own tea party.

You might wish to help your child to explore this topic at home or when you are out and about. Please feel free to approach the teachers for further explanations.

Our suggested activities are:
