How to practise spelling words

Practice each word in a silly sentence. The sillier the sentence the more memorable! Underline the spelling word in each sentence. The child or the adult could write the sentence.	Write each word and incorporate it into a silly picture. For example, 'thumb' you could draw a hand with the word written in the thumb.	Make a mini dictionary. Sort the words alphabetically and discuss the definition of each word.
Play hangman. Display all the words before beginning so the child can see which letters it may be.	Ask an adult to write an anagram (mixing up the letters) and try to work out which spelling word it is.	Paint your words onto paper, write them in water with a big brush, write them on the floor in chalk, write them in sand, make them out of play dough.
Make flash cards using post it notes and rearrange the letters to make each word. Like a puzzle.	Write out the letters in the words with different coloured pens.	Play charades with the words. When a word is guessed, spell it out.
