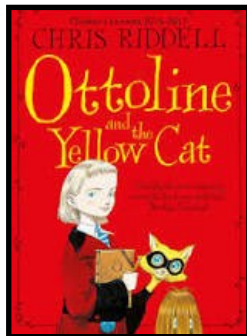


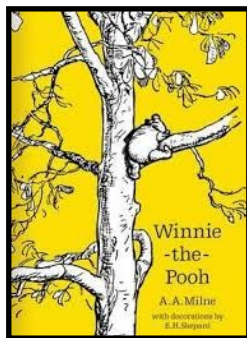
The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark Jill Tomlinson

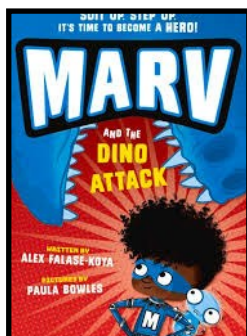
Ottoline Chris Riddell

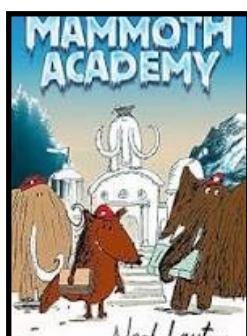
Winnie the Pooh A.A. Milne

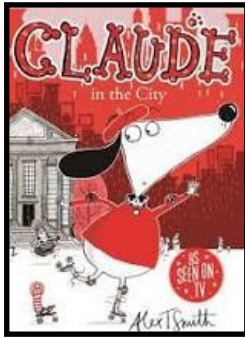
Marv and the Dino Attack Alex Falase-Koya

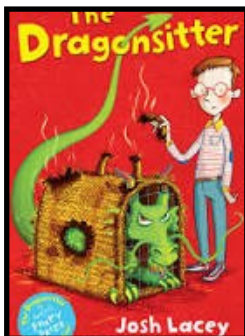


Rabbit and Bear: Rabbit's Bad Habits

Humphrey Carpenter

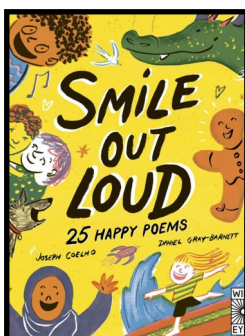

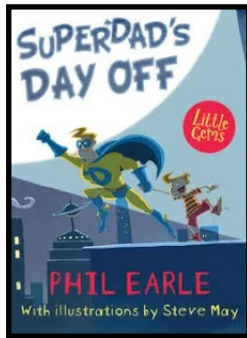

Smile Out Loud

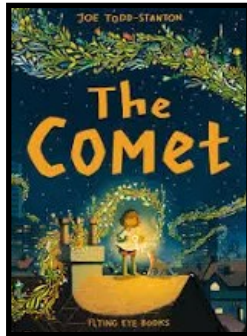

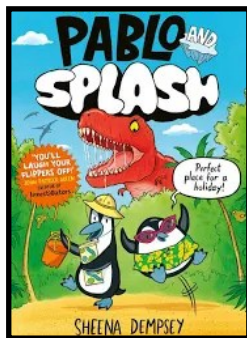
Superdad's Day Off Phil Earle

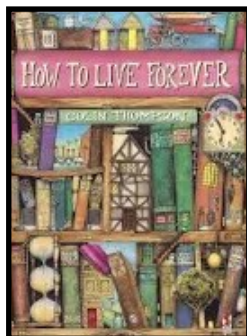
The Comet Joe Todd-Stanton

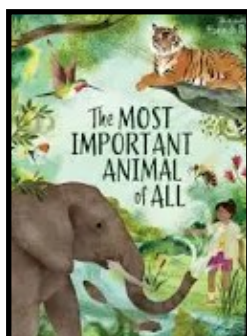
Pablo and Splash Sheena Dempsey
